

Fertilizer Sector Nov'24: Peak Rabi season uplifts urea sales

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Fertilizer Sector Nov'24: Seasonality factor increase urea sales

- The tentative fertilizer sales data depicts 7% YoY growth in urea sales for Nov'24, settling at 652k tons.
- On a company-wise basis, urea sales of FFC and FFBL Group climbed up by 16% YoY, arriving at 283k tons. Meanwhile, offtake of EFERT and FATIMA reduced by 12% and 1% YoY, clocking in at 191k tons and 124k tons, respectively.
- On a MoM basis, urea sales surged by 82% amid peak Rabi season in Nov'24. The urea dispatches of FFC and FFBL combined, EFERT, and FATIMA jumped up by 58%, 91%, and 112% MoM, respectively.
- On a cumulative basis, urea sales in 11MCY24 decreased by 7% YoY to 5,584k tons. Offtake of EFERT and FATIMA dwindled by 24% and 12% YoY, respectively settling at 1,613k tons and 805k tons, respectively. Meanwhile, urea sales of FFC and FFBL reported a 4% YoY growth, reaching 2,686k tons.

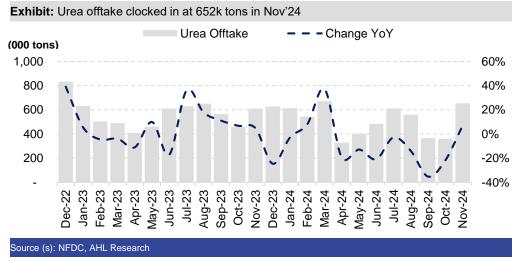

Fertilizer Sector DAP offtake decline amid weak farm economics

- DAP dispatches in Nov'24 clocked in at 270k tons, down by 3% YoY | 13% MoM owing to weak purchasing power of the farmers. With this, total offtake during 11MCY24 arrived at 1,510k tons, up 5% YoY.
- On a company-specific basis, DAP sales of FFC and FFBL combined augmented by 52% YoY to 135k tons in Nov'24. Meanwhile, the offtake declined by 14% on a MoM basis. Hence, FFC and FFBL's total DAP offtake in 11MCY24 settled at 909k tons, up 4% YoY.
- Whereas, EFERT's DAP offtake in Nov'24 declined by 18% YoY | 3% MoM to arrive at 48k tons. Hence, EFERT's DAP offtake in 11MCY24 increased by 18% YoY, arriving at 293k tons.
- FATIMA Group's DAP sales dwindled by 85% YoY, while an uptick of 1% was observed on a MoM basis at 6k tons in Nov'24. Subsequently, FATIMA's DAP offtake plunged by 53% YoY to 49k tons in 11MCY24.

Inventory position

• By the end of Nov'24, the urea inventory stood at 778k tons vis-vis 841k tons in Oct'24. Whereas, DAP inventory settled at 110k tons in Nov'24 compared to 307k tons in Oct'24.

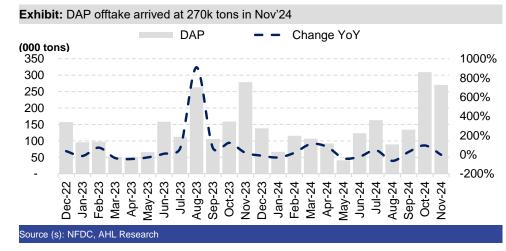
