

- Declines into the 132-133k support zone were seen on Wednesday
- 36 shares rose while 64 fell with NATF PA (+3.32%), GADT PA (+10.0%) and MEBL PA (+0.24%) contributed to most to index gains
- FFC PA (-1.04%), ENGROH PA (-1.36%), BAHL PA (-1.67%) were the biggest downside index contributors
- June overseas remittances rose +27% YoY to USD 38.2bn in FY25 to an all time high. Remittances from Saudi Arabia, UAE and the UK topped the list
- SBP Governor Jameel Ahmad said Pakistan's economy is seeing results of a tight monetary policy on inflation and current account
- The KSE-100 is expected to find support within the 132-133k zone and resume upside moves
